**Title:** AMEND EXISTING BOARD POLICY REGARDING RENTAL OF FACILITIES TO ALLOW LEASING OF SWIMMING POOLS

## **Policy:**

The leasing of swimming pools shall be authorized in accordance with requirements for issuance of School Usage Permits. All lease agreements for the rental of swimming pools shall comply with the following requirements: (1) provision of the appropriate number of lifeguards as specified by the Illinois Department of Public Health ("IDPH"), as well as demonstrated ability to comply with all other IDPH requirements governing the use and operation of swimming pools; (2) leasee's provision of liability insurance with coverage limits of not less than 3,000,000 combined single limit, which names the Board of Education as an additional insured without contribution of premium; (3) agreement of the leasee to indemnify, defend and hold harmless, the Board of Education, its employees and assigns, the scope of such indemnification to be determined by the Department of Risk Management in consultation with the Attorney for the Board; and (4) approval by the principal and LSC of the school at which the pool is located; (5) approval by the Chief Operating Officer and the Board.

In addition to the foregoing, the Board may impose such other special conditions and requirements as are recommended by the Bureau of Asset Management in consultation with the Department of Risk Management.
